1. Introduction by the Chairman. He commended the work by Elista and Commission Members.
2. He commented that there are now very few problems with the system of the PB awarding titles at their meetings which enables people to get there titles in between congresses.
3. There had been three meetings in 2010 between the Chairman and members of the QC Council and also other experts. These valuable meetings had concerned both titles and ratings.
4. Problems concerning unplayed games due to no fault of the player, especially in 9 round tournaments:
 - a. Where a player could have played an unrated opponent, who was untitled and from his own country; then the game can count as if played and he lost.
 - b. If the player just has 8 games, but he has met the right mix of opponents in those games, then, if he has the title result in 8 games, it counts as an 8 game norm.
 - c. **1.42c currently counts only for the last round. In future it can count for any round, apart from the first.**
This is a matter of some urgency and will thus be put into the regulations to take effect from 1 July 2011.

5. From 1 July 2010 until 30 June 2013 the following time control will continue to be permitted for title norms: all the moves in 90 minutes, plus 30 seconds added cumulatively from move 1.

6. There was some discussion about what the time controls should be from the new cycle starting 1 July 2013, but no conclusions were reached.

7- Round robins of more than 9 rounds. Interim results achieved in such events can only count if there would be the correct mix of players at the end of the event.

This is an interpretation of article 1.42g.

8. Pairing systems were discussed. Changes to the pre-announced system are NOT allowed. This point will be highlighted to chess administrators and players. A norm was achieved in one particular event where this rule was not followed. If agreed by the QC and eventually the General Assembly, it will be accepted. Scheveningen matches and events which are of an 'unusual' nature can only be accepted for title norms, provided the QC Chairman gives prior permission.

11. It was decided that in cases where youth age groups are combined in Youth Tournaments where automatic titles are possible, the FM/WFM titles can be awarded based on subgroup results, if the size of the subgroup is at least 7 players, in the case of CM/WCM at least 5 players.

2. The regulations of FM/WFM Titles have been changed during years causing some confusion. It was decided that an FM (WFM) title may be awarded, if the player has had a rating 2300 or higher (women 2100 or higher) on any FIDE periodically published rating list. Similarly CM/WCM may be awarded 2200/2000 ratings.

The regulations now give FM/WFM titles based on at least 66 2/3 percent result from at least 9 games and CM/WCM titles based on at least 50 percent result from at least 7 games. It was decided to apply this rule retroactively also to earlier Olympiads.

The commission recommends these.

3. The USCF proposal to change the article 1.43e was postponed to the next amendment cycle 2012.

4. The open title application since and from Halkidike were handled and decided. QC Annex 1

5. Title applications sent after the Tromsø Presidential Board were handled and decided. QC Annex 2.

6. IO title regulations were found to be somewhat unclear. It was decided that when the organizer is not a person, the application certificates must indicate the person responsible for the organization of the tournament.

7- FIDE Rating Experts meeting in Athens in June decided to propose changing the K factor for players having fewer than 30 rated games to 30 (is currently 25). Consequently the value of 0.5 point in the new player's formula is proposed to be changed to 15 (is 12.5).

The QC agreed to recommend the change to be approved.

8. The Rating meeting also proposed that after a new player has an initial rating based on at least 3 games, then each game against rated player will be cumulated to his rating (currently at least 3 games against rated opponents in a tournament).

The QC agreed to recommend the change to be approved.

9. The proposal to change the iteration in round-robin tournaments to require at least one point against rated opponents was decided to be postponed to the 2012 amendment.

10. The rating experts meeting's to study the reestablishing rapid and blitz ratings was recommended to be considered further.

11. Other proposals on the agenda to change rating regulations were postponed to 2012.

12. The Chairman pointed out that a database of all the ratings and title changes has to be created to have the players' chess histories available. Also the results of the rated tournaments should be archived to be available. A result server that stores all results sent to FIDE Rating Server should be established so that the all data can be retrieved. FIDE should either develop a system or make a contract with a company to create it. A large part of Swiss system and even round-robin tournaments are stored in Chess-Results.

13. In the case there are late applications, or some other urgent matters to be decided, the QC approved that the Chairman after consultation with the QC councilors will decide.

14. The Chairman thanked the commission members and observers for a good meeting and closed the meeting.
